



Important Watering Information for New Fescue Seed

Fescue seed needs to be kept moist - a light watering each day is all that is required to keep the seed moist. You want to water each area for 5 minutes, twice a day for the next 2-3 weeks. If you have an irrigation system, you should increase the frequency to daily watering and decrease the amount of time each zone runs. The goal is to encourage the seed to germinate and create a healthy stand of turf. After aerating & overseeding, your turf you should be watered for 14 -21 days.

Keep in mind, your grass will *not* get mowed for 4-6 weeks after the seed has been put down. The first time your newly sprouted turf is mowed, it may look a little rough. That is because we want to only make one pass over the turf while it is still young. Once the turf is healthy and strong, normal mowing will resume.
